

# Rugby Lingo

**Try** - A try happens when a player grounds the ball over the goal line. It is worth 5 points.

**Conversion** - A team gets an attempt to kick a conversion after scoring a try. A conversion is worth 2 points.

**Penalty Goal** - If an infraction of the laws happens, a team gets an opportunity to kick a penalty goal that is worth 3 points.

**Drop Goal** - During open field play, a player may attempt to kick a drop goal to score 3 points. More commonly referred to as a "Droppie".

**Knock On** - A knock on occurs when a player fumbles the ball forward.

**Scrum** - If a ball is knocked on by a player, the game is restarted with a scrum. 8 players from each team join together and battle for possession of the ball.

**Lineout** - If a player is tackled or steps out of bounds, the game is restarted with a lineout. One player throws the ball in while players from both teams lift a jumper into the air to gain possession of the ball.

**Pitch** - The game of rugby is played on a field called a pitch.
